Applications for vending will be accepted Sunday through Friday from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

1. Present your driver's license to the Market staff and fill out the application form. There is a \$5.00 non-refundable application fee.
2. To purchase an Occupational Licence at a cost of \$50.00 through December 31st, of the present year and to register for City Sales Tax present a copy of your French Market application form to the following City and State agencies:

3. Return to the French Market with license and sales tax forms, and rent your space for whichever days you wish to sell (seven days a week). Please note, there is a \$25.00 charge for a Vendor ID Card and, the Market does not accept checks from a new vendor for the first (30) days.
