



FLEA MARKET VENDOR APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications for vending will be accepted every day between 10:00 AM and 4:00 PM at the Flea Market office, 1235 N. Peters Street, New Orleans, LA 70116.

Prospective vendors are required to call or email for an appointment where they must show samples to enter into the approval process. [(504) 596-3420] amaier@frenchmarket.org

In order to become a vendor in the French Market's Flea Market, please follow these steps:

- Present photo identification to the market staff and fill out the application form. There is a \$5.00 non-refundable application fee.
- Purchase an Occupational License at a cost of \$50.00 for the present year and register for City Sales Tax at:
 ---City Hall, 1300 Perdido Street--First Floor--Room 1W15 Department of Finance/ Bureau of Revenue [(504) 658-1655]
 You will need to present the copy of your approved application and your French Market Corporation receipt for this process.
- Register with the Louisiana Department of Revenue for Sales Tax ONLINE PROCESS. <http://rev.louisiana.gov/sections/business/intro.aspx>
 After completing application print proof of registration to bring back to Market office
- Return to the Market office (1235 N. Peters Street) with your occupational license and both sales tax forms. You will need to have your photo taken for a vendor identification card (\$25.00 fee).
 Welcome new vendor! You are ready to your join in morning process to rent space and sell at the French market Community Flea market!

Please note, the Market does not accept checks from a new vendor for the first (30) days.

- Mass produced souvenirs
- Sundresses
- Sunglasses
- T-shirts

Products and Services Prohibited by Market Policy

- Consumable items/food in Farmer's Market area only
- Counterfeit Goods
- Drugs & Drug Paraphernalia, Surgical tools
- Duplication of License plates or photo ID's (state & drivers licenses)
- Explicit Sexual Materials
- Live Animals--Any Products of Endangered Species
- Massage
- Phone Cards
- Professional Advisors, Solicitation for other businesses or services
- Tobacco and smoking related products
- Weapons, including knives and toy weapons
